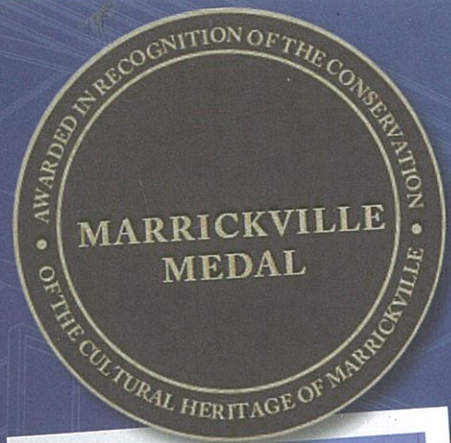


2018 BUILT ENVIRONMENT AWARDS

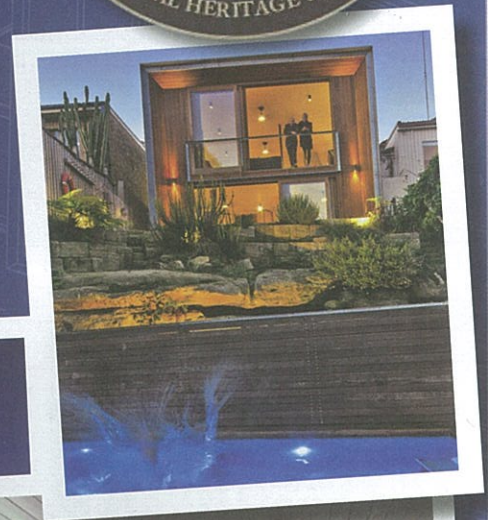


The restitution of a riverside terrace house in Marrickville has taken out the 2018 Marrickville Medal for Conservation.

The judges noted that Mackenzie Pronk Architects oversaw "excellent conservation and streetscape outcomes" and "thoughtful attention to the geography of Marrickville and the Cooks River".

The original 1886 Victorian Italianate terrace house's detail had been removed last century, with lost elements including the front balcony, iron lace and cast iron columns.

Replacements were either sourced from demolition yards or reconstructed, while the original timber floors and tessellated tiles were uncovered and restored.



Julie Gabriel won the Open category of the 2018 Urban Photography Awards with *New Canterbury Road*, which the judges described as "a well exposed, punchy and vibrant photo taken at a beautiful time of day ... Love the colours and the clean and simple lines."
